From Our Rabbi

"In the depth of winter, I finally learned that within me there lay an invincible summer." – Albert Camus

In Jewish thought, there is an ancient and treasured concept known as Menuchat Ha'Nefesh—spiritual tranquility. The classic work Chovot HaLevavot (Duties of the Heart) describes Menuchat Ha'Nefesh as the serene state that emerges when a person places genuine trust in Hashem and recognizes that even in life's quiet or dormant moments, a divine plan is unfolding. This sense of inner peace offers a perfect lens through which to view the season we find ourselves in.

As we turn the page into late winter and begin to look toward spring, our Jewish calendar brings us the beautiful holiday of Tu B'Shvat. This "New Year of the Trees" reminds us that even in the heart of winter, the sap is rising unseen within the branches, and the promise of new growth has already begun. Tu B'Shvat invites us to notice those subtle, hopeful beginnings beneath the surface and to cultivate Menuchat Ha'Nefesh—a tranquil trust in the unfolding of Hashem's plan.

In a playful parallel, we also observe Groundhog Day on February 2nd. While it remains a piece of lighthearted folklore, it nudges us to look forward to the end of winter and the coming of spring. Just as the groundhog's shadow serves as a whimsical symbol of what lies ahead, Tu B'Shvat is our Jewish reminder that renewal is already stirring and that redemption and growth are in motion even when we cannot yet see them.

So as we celebrate Tu B'Shvat this year, let's take a moment to look for the small signs of spiritual renewal in our own lives. Whether we are facing personal struggles or simply feeling a bit disconnected, we can hold onto these gentle reminders that hope and renewal are already beginning to blossom. Just like the trees of Tu B'Shvat—and even the playful promise of Groundhog Day—may we discover those tiny sparks of spring within our own spiritual journey and embrace Menuchat Ha'Nefesh along the way.

Message from our Co-President

The Hebrew months of Tevet and Shevat are not filled with major Jewish holidays but here at Temple B'nai Jacob of Wellington, we have two very special traditions to observe together. Our Woman's League Shabbat weekend will be on January 16 and 17 and our Tu B'Shevat Seder will be held the evening of Sunday, February first.

Under the guidance and direction of our Woman's League President, Ella Bender, the women of TBJ have been leading the Woman's League Shabbat since our founding in 2007. We all have assigned responsibilities for this Service; some which require dedicated hours of preparation. It is an honor to participate and we know that Rabbi Dan and our Shabbat prayer leaders enjoy joining our congregants for this very emotional and enlightening week-end. Many thanks to Ella and all of our Woman's League sisters who participate.

The 15th of Shevat, on the Jewish calendar—celebrated this year on Monday, Feb. 2, 2026—is the day that marks the beginning of a “new year” for trees.

Tu B'Shevat, marks the season in which the earliest-blooming trees in the Land of Israel emerge from their winter sleep and begin a new fruit-bearing cycle. It is believed that almond trees are the first of all trees in Israel to blossom. Our TBJ Tu B'Shevat seder brings us together at the Seder table led by Rabbi Dan. We mark the 15th of Shevat by eating fruit and nuts, particularly from the kinds that are singled out by the Torah in its praise of the bounty of Eretz Israel, our Holy Land: grapes, figs, pomegranates, olives, almonds and dates. On this day we remember that “man is a tree of the field”. We mark the progression of the seasons and note each of the seven species.

This is also an appropriate time to remember our role in supporting Israel. You don't need to be in Israel to make purchases that will help support the economy of our homeland. Every tree planted, every fruit enjoyed and every Israeli product purchased strengthens our unbreakable bond with our homeland. Explore the internet, you will see there are many opportunities to make purchases from Israeli companies with minor or no shipping charges. Purchasing goods directly from Israel—whether tech-items, Judaica, cosmetics, artisanal crafts or clothing—helps support Israel's export economy and strengthens domestic businesses. Every on line purchase you make sends money to Israeli sellers, which helps small and medium sellers survive and expand. This Tu B'Shevat celebrate Israeli treasures, by supporting those who keep traditions alive, bring a piece of Israel into your home.

May this coming year of 2026 be a year of peace, healing, re-building, and solidarity for our Jewish community.
