From Our Rabbi

Ninety percent of life is just showing up.” – Woody Allen

As summer rolls in and routines relax, it's tempting to think that synagogue attendance can too. With vacations planned, school out, and even your rabbi away for a few Shabbatot, it's easy to fall into the mindset of "I'll come back in the fall." But showing up—even when things are quiet—matters more than we often realize.

Judaism has always valued consistency. In *Pirkei Avot* (2:13), Rabbi Shimon says: **"Hevei zahir b'kri'at Shema u'vaTefillah" – "Be meticulous in the recitation of Shema and prayer."**

The word *zahir* doesn't just mean "careful"—it also means "radiant." When we stay committed, even in quieter moments, we bring light into our community and into ourselves.

A story is told of a holy rabbi who once noticed that his synagogue was emptier than usual during the summer. Before Mincha one Shabbat afternoon, he stepped outside and called out, "Jews! Come to shul! Even if you're coming only out of habit, Hashem loves those habits! And when your feet come through the door, sometimes your heart follows after." That Shabbat, the sanctuary filled—not from guilt, but from inspiration and love.

Your presence in the sanctuary isn't just about filling a seat. It uplifts others and affirms that this community matters. It sends a powerful message - to your children, your friends, and yourself - that Judaism isn't seasonal. It's a lifelong journey, and every step, every "showing up," counts.

Judaism doesn't take a summer break, even when the rabbi does. The doors of our tradition remain wide open. Our TBJ synagogue will continue to be vibrantly open, and services will be just as beautifully meaningful as ever. Please know: we are always better when you are here.

Message from our Co-President

As one of the many leaders of Temple B'nai Jacob of Wellington, the recent attacks in Boulder, Colorado, and Washington, D.C are disturbing. Now we have the Iran bombing of Israel, the US bombing of the Iran nuclear facilities, and the retaliation toward our bases in the middle east. These are reminders of our responsibility to remain vigilant despite years of hardening our security measures and trying to keep our congregation safe.

Forty-Three Jewish Organizations from all over the world are sounding the alarm for more help after a dozen people were injured in Boulder while demonstrating for the release of Israeli hostages in Gaza last month. And just over a week earlier, two Israeli Embassy staffers were fatally shot outside a Jewish Museum in Washington. They issued a joint statement requesting more support from the U.S. government for enhanced security measures. Specifically, they asked Congress to increase funding to the Nonprofit Security Grant Program to \$1 billion. *"These are the everyday realities of Jewish life in the 21st century in America. It's a sad reality, but it is an essential responsibility of leadership to make sure that people are first and foremost safe."*

Shira Hutt, executive vice president at The Jewish Federations of North America, said *"existing federal funds were inadequate, with only 43% of last year's applicants to the grant program receiving funding."*

Well, I am here to tell you that we received another security grant from the Jewish Federation of Palm Beach County. This grant is to not only combat Antisemitism but to further protect our congregation. This was a cumbersome process, but by the first week of July a new front door buzzer lock system should be completed followed by multiple security camera installations.

I've heard from members that attend regular Shabbat Services that they are feeling very nervous right now and having some additional security will make people feel a little bit more comfortable. There's a definite sense that the attacks in the United States are not isolated events, that these attacks are, in part, the result of a lot of the antisemitic rhetoric that we've been hearing in society for years now.

We can't let this define us and we can't stop doing what we do, we can't stop coming to synagogue and we can't stop having our activities. This is not the time to be afraid and not show up. Be proud to be a Jew.

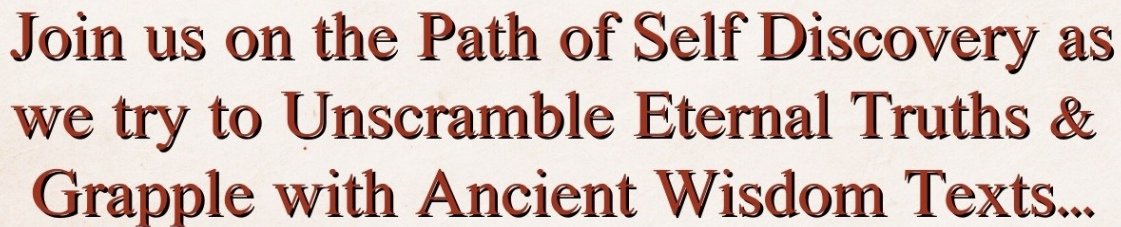

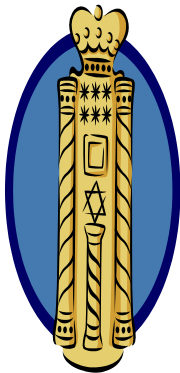

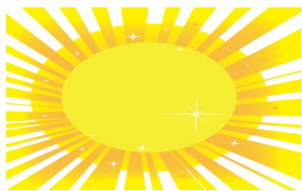
