## From Our Rabbi

"...and sometimes I act like I'm about thirteen." —J.D. Salinger, The Catcher in the Rye

In just a few short weeks, our family will share a very special moment with all of you. On Shabbat, May 31, 2025, our oldest son, Avi, will become a Bar Mitzvah.

As a rabbi, I've had the joy of watching many of our young people step up to the Torah, their faces filled with nervous excitement and pride. Now, it's my own son's turn—and let me tell you, nothing quite prepares you for this moment!

*Bar Mitzvah* translates to "son of the commandment." While it marks the official age when a young person takes on full responsibility for the mitzvot, between you and me, it also seems to mark the moment they grow taller than their rabbi!

The Talmud in Pirkei Avot tells us that at thirteen, a young person is obligated to fulfill the commandments. The Halachic text of the Chafetz Chaim, known as the *Mishnah Berurah*, states: "Bar mitzvah — that is, when he turns 13 and 1 day... now he has become a man in Israel, commanded in the Torah's commandments." I say it's also the time we start recruiting them to help make the minyan!

Watching my son prepare has been a journey more profound and heartwarming than I could have imagined. From teaching him how to chant the melody of the Torah to sharing some of my well-guarded rabbinic secrets (like how to find the perfect joke to break the ice!), every moment has been a treasure.

As he reads from the Torah and delivers his *Dvar Torah*, Avi will be weaving his thread into the tapestry of our tradition. This isn't just about a single day of celebration; it's about watching a young soul stand tall, eager to carry the legacy of countless generations before him.

As we look forward to this wonderful day, I'm reminded of the vital role we all play in nurturing the flame of faith and heritage in our children's hearts. Your smiles, encouragement, and engagement means the world to us—and to them. I hope you will continue to offer our young people, especially my children, your wisdom and warmth. After all, who else will teach them how to gather the perfect amount at the Oneg and Kiddush, or master the subtle art of shul politics?

May this special occasion inspire all our children and grandchildren to embrace their journeys with joy and courage. In the words of our tradition, may they grow "from strength to strength," finding their unique path in our rich faith.

As for my son, Avi—may he always find joy in every commandment, every deed, every moment of learning. May he always feel Hashem's Love Tickling him and being the Source of complete joy and happiness. May he always wear his Judaism with pride, may it always be the essence of his identity, and mayhe always have the courage to be his authentic self — and may he still laugh at his dad's jokes, no matter how old they get.

Rachel, Avi, Ezra, Nisa, and I look forward to celebrating with each and every one of you. Kiddush to follow!






