Message from our President

I was recently asked what do you do as President of a small Synagogue?

There is no Executive Director and, because of the small pool of Congregants, it can become a lifetime appointment. Anyone who has been a synagogue member or professional knows that the synagogue president is the unsung hero. The synagogue president, often by personal nature and always by congregational approval, is the number one volunteer at a synagogue who performs work that often borders on being a full-time unpaid job. The president is charged with vast governance, management, and financial responsibilities. Partnering with the clergy, overseeing the business operations of the a synagogue, presiding over the governance of the congregation, and serving as the chief financial officer and revenue generator is just the tip of the iceberg of a modern synagogue president's responsibilities.

As you may remember from comments by Rabbi Krinsky and me during the High Holy Days, Outreach and Community continues to be a major focus for our congregation. This Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur we had pretty much all our members (our Community) take part in the services. The vast majority of the members were very pleased to be called and thought it was a really nice thing to do. Now that we are starting a New Year, some members had suggestions, concerns and criticisms. There are some issues that cannot be addressed. For instance, when we have one member says, "there's too much Hebrew in the service" and another says, "there's not enough Hebrew", it would be quite a feat to make both congregants happy. However, there are many things that we can do to make TBJ a more welcoming and responsive synagogue, and we will respond to some of the comments to let you know that the Rabbi and TBJ leadership are listening. There should be a confidential way that members can air suggestions, grievances or address sensitive problems. The Board and the Committee on Membership and Synagogue Community recognize that the best time to address the concerns of a dissatisfied congregant is before that member thinks about leaving. The Board and the Executive Committee serve the entire congregation; if members have particular suggestions or problems, they should feel comfortable calling or writing to any of us.

Our membership has declined again this year which could potentially lead to the end of synagogue life as we know it. However, as most of you know, synagogue life, whether you attend one or two days a year or every week of the year, is vital to us to maintain our Jewish identity.

I want to thank all of you that made your donation to TBJ for this New Year. As I have said many times, dues and tuition do not come close to keeping us functioning the way We want to. Therefore, if you haven't made your High Holiday donation this year yet, please consider a generous donation to TBJ.

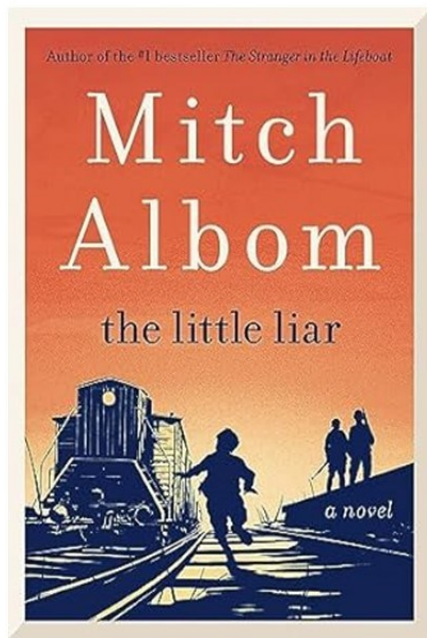

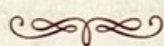

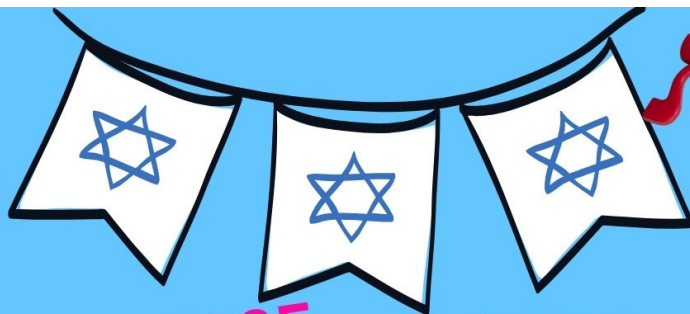
Peace, God, please, God.

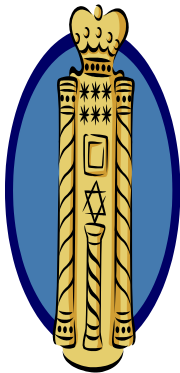

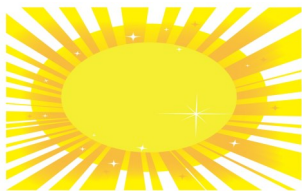
