From Our Rabbi

“How awesome are Your works!” - Psalm 66:3

This past July, Rachel, Avi, Ezra, Nisa, and I went on a road-trip that lasted several weeks. We, initially, drove to North Carolina, to drop the boys off at camp. From that point on, it was the “Nisa Tour,” mostly visiting extended family and friends throughout New Jersey and New York, with several detoured stops along the way. While visiting Asheville, and after driving for, what seemed to be, a considerably long time, up a mountain, twisting and turning along a very windy road, we finally reached our desired destination. After parking the car and walking a short distance, Rachel and I (and Nisa, of course) got to witness an amazing sight. The place is called Jump Off Rock and offers an “overlook with panoramic mountain views.” The best way to describe it, especially after the drive we had getting there - Awesome!

This word, “Awesome,” has, seemingly, lost its power and effectiveness over the years. We, often, read the word in translations of prayers and scriptures as referring to Hashem or something extremely holy. Nowadays, if we like a specific restaurant, we might tell a friend, “The food was awesome!” This was particularly noteworthy to a teacher of mine in rabbinical seminary. Being from England, this one Rabbi always got a kick out of the American students mundane use of the word, “Awesome.” He would, jokingly, mock us by using the word at bizarre moments. I’m, vividly, remembering his warm grin as I write about this, something that happened over 25 years ago. Perhaps, we must bring back some of the “Awe” to the word, “Awesome.”

At its root is the word, “Awe.” Something that is “Awesome” tends to be Awe-inspiring and deeply moving. “Awe is a sense of transcendence, for the reference everywhere to Him who is beyond all things,” taught Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel in his book, *G-d in Search of Man*. Heschel continued to explain: “Awe is a way of being in rapport with the mystery of all reality. The awe that we sense or ought to sense when standing in the presence of a human being is a moment of intuition for the likeness of G-d which is concealed in his essence. Not only man; even inanimate things stand in relation to the Creator. The secret of every being is the divine care and concern that are **invested in it**. Something sacred is at stake in every event. Awe is an intuition for the **creaturely dignity of all things and their preciousness to G-d**...Awe, unlike fear, does not make us shrink from the awe-inspiring object, but on the contrary, **draws us near to it**. This is why awe is compatible with both love and joy.”

In the Torah (Genesis 28:17), Jacob, upon awaking from his famous ladder-dream sleep, says: “*Mah **Norah** HaMakom HaZeh!*” or “How **awesome** is this place!” The Zohar comments: “What did he see that he said it was *Norah*/Awesome?... He saw **wholeness** of sacred faith, which was found in that place, and in every place where **completeness** is found - that place is called ***Norah/Awesome***.” At the moments and in the places where we find ourselves enveloped with a sense of completeness and wholeness, that is precisely when our word of choice should be - Awesome.

We are approaching the meaningful time of the Jewish year known as the *Yom'im Norah'im*, The Days of Awe. Or, as I, often, refer to them as the Days of Awesome! The Days of Awe - Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, extending into Sukkot, Shemini Atzeret and Simchat Torah - is the time for us to reconnect to the Awesome, to what is Awesome, and to shine forth what is truly Awesome within us. We must allow ourselves to feel Awe-inspired and the sense of completeness and wholeness, even if only for a moment. The world outside appears to be fragmented and fractured, however, we can transcend into a sacred space, creating a sacred place that is filled with an Awe that will “draw us near to it.” That should be the commitment we make ourselves as we enter into the Days of Awe 2024. A commitment to help create the holy and sacred, awe-filled space within our sanctuary these coming holidays. A commitment to allow ourselves to feel and experience the prayers, melodies and texts with a renewed sense of Awe and beauty. Let us all commit to making these Days of Awe simply and truly, **Awesome!**

Message from our President

The pandemic is finally behind us and we are expecting another full house for the High Holidays. Again, all services will be held at our Synagogue. As you know, space is limited so when we contact you and ask you when and how many will be attending, please respond in a timely manner. We are delighted to be celebrating our four-year anniversary this Rosh Hashanah with our Rabbi Daniel Krinsky who has brought us his energy, enthusiasm, and deep spirituality while showing us new ways to connect with Judaism. This year Cantor Shayndel Adler from Denver, Colorado will again be with us for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur services. Those of you that were with us last year overwhelmingly enjoyed her davening.

However, this year will be a little different. Between Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur will be the one-year anniversary of the October 7th massacre in Israel. Israel is still at war and over 100 people are still being held hostage. No other war in the history of all wars has been under such international scrutiny. No other country attacked by terrorists of all kinds from all borders has ever been called a “terrorist state” when defending its citizens. I could keep going but you get the idea. On October 7, 2024, the Jewish Federation of Palm Beach County is inviting our entire community to remember the horrific events that impacted the Jewish and Israeli people one year ago. The program will honor those who were lost with a heartfelt memorial. Yet, following Jewish tradition, we will not dwell solely on tragedy. We will celebrate the enduring strength of our people through inspiring words and music. This will be a powerful testament to our enduring hope. There will be more details to follow but we are a participating synagogue for this event. The evening will feature speakers from Israel, American Jews, and our esteemed allies in Palm Beach County.

Moving on, I want to call out the tremendous work of our TBJ Board of Directors and all of our volunteers. Let me be clear; we have no aspirations to be a “big” congregation. Being a small, welcoming, and intimate community is an integral part of who we are and that isn’t going to change. At the same time, we want to see TBJ thrive and one sign of a healthy, thriving community is growth in numbers. The reality is that to continue to provide the level of services that our community desires and to ensure the future stability of our congregation, we need to be larger. Although we want to grow, we recognize that growth is a challenge in an environment where synagogue affiliation has declined nationwide and in Palm Beach County, where people have many choices about where to affiliate or not at all.

Our membership numbers are down. Many are struggling financially and need help as never before. We rely on fundraising for a very significant portion of our budget. Typically, funds raised during the high holidays are a critical component of our operating budget. We tell it like it is; we have faith, and rely on the generosity of each and every one of the members of our community to contribute as much as they can to this appeal. Members and friends will be receiving a letter from the Temple encouraging our supporters to take some time between now and Yom Kippur to consider the words I have shared today. If you gave last year, is there any way you can meet or exceed your commitment? If you are new to our Kehilla, now would be a powerful time to support Jewish life in Wellington.

The future of our congregation depends on the willingness of all of you to step forward and pitch in either by volunteering or giving financial support.

Sallee and I look forward to a year of good health, joy and success for you, your families, and for the entire TBJ community.

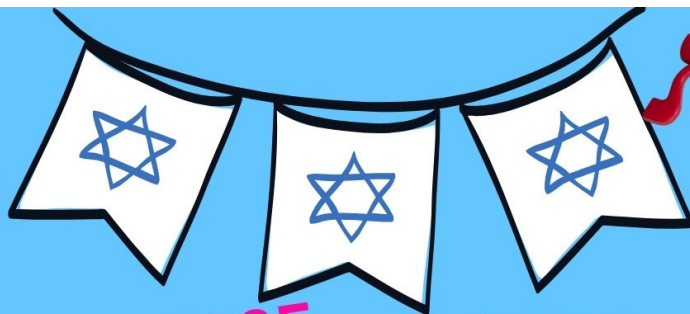
Peace, God, please, God.

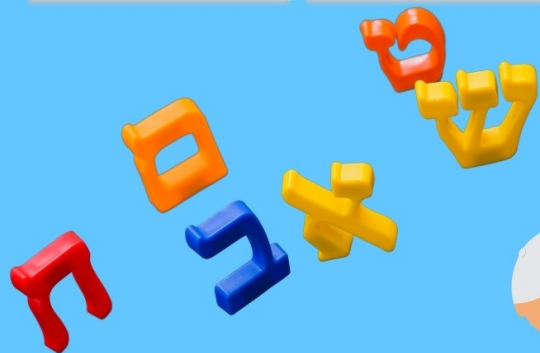

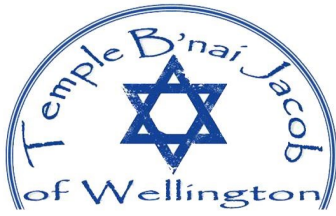

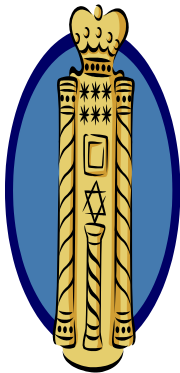
