From Our Rabbi

In the midst of chaos, there is also opportunity. —Sun Tzu

As the shofar blasts and our calendars fill with services, meals, and preparations, it's easy to feel that the High Holidays arrive with chaos. From the physical rush of cooking and hosting to the emotional weight of reflection and repentance, Rosh Hashanah to Yom Kippur, continuing through Sukkot, Simchat Torah and Shmini Atzeret, can feel more like a whirlwind than a sanctuary.

What if the intensity is the opportunity? The Hebrew word for repentance—**Teshuvah**—doesn't mean "punishment" or "guilt." It means "return." We're not running from ourselves—we're returning to ourselves. Beneath the distractions, the busy-ness, and even the stress, there is a core of holiness that this season invites us to rediscover.

As Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel wrote, "*Faith is not clinging to a shrine but the endless pilgrimage of the heart.*" The High Holidays are not a test to pass, but a journey to take. The whirlwind is real—but so is the still, small voice waiting to be heard within it.

Author Brené Brown teaches, "*You can choose courage or you can choose comfort. You cannot have both. Not at the same time.*" Teshuvah takes courage—the courage to pause, reflect, and realign our lives with our values, our hopes, our people and our G-d.

So this year, let's reframe the chaos not as something to escape, but as a *portal* to transformation. Let's notice the divine opportunity hidden in the hectic pace—the chance to slow down spiritually, even if we're running physically. Let's make space for that return. Let's return to gratitude, saying *Modeh Ani/ Thank you* each morning with a little more presence. Let's return to kindness with an extra smile, a softer word, a gentler judgment. Let's return to community by showing up in shul not just to *attend* but to *connect*.

The intensity of the High Holidays is not a burden—it's a gift. It shakes us, awakens us, and if we let it, it remakes us.

May this season of return bring us clarity, compassion, and connection - And may the chaos lead us home!

Shanah Tovah U'Metukah – !!!a sweet and meaningful New Year of 5786 to us, our loved ones, and the whole world. *Amen!*
